

**ORDINANCE NO. 3 - 2017**

**TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 7-3.4, "PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS" OF FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE CHAPTER VII, "TRAFFIC"**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Fairfield, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Fairfield situate in Cumberland County, New Jersey continues to review and update its traffic ordinances while bearing in mind issues evolving out of public health and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee seeks to address a parking issue along certain streets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee has been advised that based upon health and public safety concerns, there is need for an update to the parking ordinance on certain drives in Fairfield Township based upon the input of the New Jersey State Police, Fairton Fire and EMS, the OEM Office of Fairfield Township and complaints from residents in the affected areas;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Fairfield, County of Cumberland and State of New Jersey as follows:

**Chapter VII, TRAFFIC, Subsection 7-3.4, Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets**. No person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified in Schedule II of any day (except Sundays and Public holidays) upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule II attached to and made part of this chapter.

## SCHEDULE II

### PARKING PROHIBITED CERTAIN HOURS

In accordance with the provisions of subsection 7-3.4, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 7:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets.

- Longview Drive, Both sides of street, Commencing at the intersection of Longview Drive and E. Commerce St., continuing the length of Longview Drive to the intersection with Reeves Road.
- King Drive, Both sides of street, Commencing at the intersection of King Drive and E. Commerce St., continuing the length of King Drive to the intersection with Reeves Road.
- Walden Drive, Both sides of street, Commencing at the intersection of Walden Drive and E. Commerce St., continuing the length of Walden Drive to the intersection with Reeves Road.
- Hartz Drive, Both sides of street, Commencing at the intersection of Hartz Drive and Walden Drive, continuing the length of Hartz Drive to the intersection with Gruber Drive.
- Gruber Drive, Both sides of street, Commencing at the intersection of Gruber Drive and Hartz Drive, continuing the length of Gruber Drive to the intersection with Coombs Drive.
- Coombs Drive, Both sides of street, Commencing at the intersection of Coombs Drive and Walden Drive, continuing the length of Coombs Drive to the intersection with Gouldtown-Woodruff Road (County Rt. 553).
- Rogers Drive, Both sides of street, Commencing at the intersection of Rogers Drive and Hartz Drive, continuing across the intersection of Rogers Drive and Coombs Drive for the full length of Rogers Drive to the intersection with Gouldtown-Woodruff Road (County Rt. 553).

From the full enactment of this ordinance forward, parking shall be prohibited between the hours of 7:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. on both sides of the streets identified in Schedule II, and in the event of a violation of this ordinance, Fairfield Township ordinance 7-12, PENALTY, shall apply based upon the violation and the penalty and tow away authority as prescribed under the applicable Fairfield Township ordinance shall apply.


**Section One. Repealer.** All former Ordinances of the Township of Fairfield which are in conflict with the provisions contained in this Ordinance are hereby repealed upon the adoption of this Ordinance.

**Section Two. Severability.** If any part or parts of this Ordinance are held to be invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section Three.** This Ordinance shall take effect after final approval and publication as required by law.
