ORDINANCE NO. 2-2019

THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY

CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A DUMP TRUCK FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000) THEREFORE

THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring), DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Fairfield, County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey (the "Township"), as general capital improvements. For the improvements or purposes described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$35,000 as required by the Local Bond Law. The total sum is now available by virtue of surplus funds available within the Capital Fund Balance.

SECTION 2.

The Township hereby authorizes the appropriation of \$35,000 from the Capital Fund for the purpose of purchasing a Dump Truck for the Public Works Department for the Township, including all materials and equipment necessary or incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

SECTION 3.

The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are not current expenses. They are all improvements or purposes that the Township may lawfully undertake as general improvements, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.

SECTION 4.

Any grant moneys received for the purposes described in Section 2 hereof shall be applied to the direct payment of the cost of the improvements.

SECTION 5.

The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget will be filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

SECTION 6.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication as required by law.
