

ORDINANCE NO. 5 - 2021

**THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD IN
THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY**

**CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VEHICLE IMPROVEMENTS,
INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE PURCHASE OF A SALTBOX
FOR 2020 F-350 DUMP TRUCK AND BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS TO
THE PUBLIC WORKS GARAGE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD, IN
THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING
TWENTY TWO - THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$22,000) THEREFORE**

THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRFIELD IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring), DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Fairfield, County of Cumberland, State of New Jersey (the "Township"), as general capital improvements. For the improvements or purposes described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$22,000 as required by the Local Bond Law. The total sum is now available by virtue of surplus funds available within the Capital Improvement Fund Balance.

SECTION 2.

The Township hereby authorizes the appropriation of \$22,000 from the Capital Fund for Vehicle Improvements, including but not limited to the purchase of a saltbox for 2020 F-350 Dump Truck and Building Improvements to the Public Works Garage including all materials and equipment necessary or incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

SECTION 3.

The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are not current expenses. They are all improvements or purposes that the Township may lawfully undertake as general improvements, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.

SECTION 4.

Any grant moneys received for the purposes described in Section 2 hereof shall be applied to the direct payment of the cost of the improvements.

SECTION 5.


The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget will be filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

SECTION 6.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication as required by law.


